ELECTRICAL TESTING & TAGGING

OHSW Regulations 1995
Division 2.5.7(1), (2) – Inspection and testing of electrical plant

Australian Standards
AS/NZS 3760 – In-service safety inspection and testing of electrical equipment

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure all sites maintain electrical equipment to ensure a safe work environment is provided and legislative compliance is met.

BACKGROUND:

It has been identified that the practice for testing and tagging of electrical equipment in some worksites is NOT compliant with the legislative requirements and hence may present a risk for employees.

PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:

Competent person:

- Persons conducting testing & tagging of electrical equipment MUST have completed the unit UEEN EEP008B with a registered training organisation (RTO)
- Worksites MUST retain a copy of the contractors Statement of Attainment in the above unit or their Electrical Licence with all testing and tagging documentation.

Test & Tag Equipment:

Equipment used to test electrical equipment MUST be calibrated annually
