FRAGILE ROOFING

OHSW Regulations 1995 Division 2.3.3 – Fragile Roofing Materials Division 2.13 – Prevention of Falls

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure all sites are informed of the risk to safety associated with fragile roofing and are aware of preventative actions to reduce this risk.

BACKGROUND:

There have been several reported incidents and near miss occurrences of falls from height related to fragile roofing. These have occurred across all sectors.

PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:

- Inspect the worksite to identify all areas of Fragile Roofing (Business Manager Task No. 72839)
 - Document outcome of inspection on Business Manager Task No. 72839
 - Parishes note on bottom of POP Return for March 2010
- > Confirm Fragile Roofing is meshed:
 - Mesh is NOT required in the following circumstances:
 - If the roof pitch is >45°
 - If the worksite has <u>documented evidence</u> that the roofing material complies with AS1562.3
- > Ensure all Fragile Roofing is identified with signage
- If uncertain regarding requirement contact your OHS Consultant at Catholic Safety Health & Welfare immediately
- > Conduct a risk assessment on all work at height
