



PURCHASE AND USE OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT 1st November 2011

REFERENCE:

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure worksites are aware of the required supportive documents and information for the purchase and use of plant and equipment.

BACKGROUND:

Injury occurrence relating to the use of second hand plant

PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:

- Conduct and document a risk assessment for all high risk plant and equipment (include: purchase, installation and use)
- Consult with end user
- > Refer to manufacturer's instructions and supportive documentation
- Develop a Safe Operating Procedure (SOP)
- Ensure all staff are aware and adhere to the SOP
- > Maintain records of maintenance/servicing
- Review risk assessment at a minimum of 5 yearly
