# PERSONAL ELECTRICAL ITEMS – STUDENT USE 29<sup>TH</sup> July 2014

#### REFERENCE:

WHS Act 2012 Cl's 17, 19 & 21
WHS Regulations 2012 – Part 7
CSH&WSA Document No. 9 – Electrical Procedure

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

To ensure all worksites have a process in place to manage any personal electrical items brought onto the site.

#### BACKGROUND:

Recently the back of an electrical transformer (similar to the picture below) separated from the 2 pin face exposing the live brass contacts. A student using the item touched the exposed contacts and received an electric shock.

The item involved was an <u>FM Hearing System (PHONAK)</u>. The supplier has removed current chargers from worldwide stock and is investigating the need to recall all Units sold after 2008.





#### **PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:**

- o **REMOVE** any **Phonak FM Hearing Systems** from use, until further notice
- o NO electrical item should be brought on site without the Principal or manager's approval
- The school must determine a process to manage electrical items and equipment brought onto site. This includes items 'on loan' from any support agencies, eg Novita, Autism SA
- Conduct a risk assessment of the use of the item at the school
- o Implement controls identified during the risk assessment
- Should the school proceed with purchasing electrical equipment the item MUST be placed on the Electrical Register and tested and tagged
